LOOKING FOR A NEW LOVE?

As the Grammys get smaller in our rear view and spring is a distant light at the end of a cold tunnel, this time of year becomes a treasure trove of smaller artists hoping to catch your eye before the year's big releases hit. So, if you're looking to fall in love before Valentine's Day, these new artists/releases are much less likely to break your heart than that Pablo guy you met at The SoFo Tap last night.

Dutch crooner/producer **Mar** is set to release his second EP of abstract, minimal soul, *Form*. If you've been a fan of Frank Ocean and Miguel, imagine someone doing even more with a Marvin Gaye tone, and having started to do it a year before they did. Some of the sexiest music I've truly ever heard. With this new EP it sounds like he's even working in light touches of '90s house as well.



British producer/vocalist **Sohn**, part of a new wave of groundbreaking artist signed to the legendary 4AD label (see last week's column) has just released his second single, "Lessons," to much buzz. *Lessons* first comes off as blue-eyed soul with a Giorgio Moroder '80s synth, but builds to a pulsating, urgent crescendo with chopped and screwed vocals, then back down to quiet soul.

Sohn has also recently started working with the soulful **Kwabs**, who, at only one official single, has already been named the artist to watch by MTV-UK. Kwabs' vocals are so low and rich, it actually takes a moment to adjust and realize his vocals aren't pitched down for effect. This range is really that ball-rumblingly deep. Mar's very reminiscent of greats like Alexander O'Neal, Jerry Butler and Teddy Pendergrass.

And finally on a slightly lighter note, if you're fan of Lil' Kim (but think she lost it a decade ago) or Azealia Banks (but think she's never going to release that first album), check out Detroit rapper/singer **Angel Haze**. She comes off like a tolerable Nicki Minaj switching it up between concise, smart rhymes and Santigold/MIA-style pop songs, even going full drama-pop like Emeli Sande on the epic "Battle Cry." For sure she's one to watch for 2014.
